Recommendations and suggestions made by NAAC Peer Team

During the Visit of 2nd Cycle

Rupahi College was accorded C⁺ grade by NAAC on 4th November, 2004. The IQAC was established on 05.08.2005 as per instructions from NAAC to carry out the post accreditation duties and responsibilities of the college. The IQAC has been institutionalized as a major part of the institutional decision-making mechanism. Efforts have been made to improve, among other things, infrastructure facilities by tapping all available sources of funding.

NAAC Peer Team Visited the college on 15 to 17 OCT. 2015 and made the following recommendations and Suggestions for Enhancement of Quality of the Institution during 2nd cycle:

1. Science and Commerce subjects at under graduate level as well as post graduate course in some disciplines should be introduced in the college.
2. Full automation of the college library is needed.
3. Wi-Fi facility should be strengthened and ICT enabled teaching-learning processes be introduced.
4. Measures should be taken to improve communication skills of students in Hindi and English.
5. Hostel should be made functional for both boys and girls.
6. Facilities should be provided to physically challenged students.
7. Canteen, mess, parking and sports facilities should be upgraded as per modern standards.
8. Better medical facilities be provided to students, teaching and non-teaching staff.
9. Vehicle facility must be provided to students since they come from very remote areas.
10. Proper 'Skill Development Centre' be established to help the self-employment of rural youth.

POST ACCREDITATION INITIATIVES:

After the accreditation of 2nd cycle of our college in 2015, Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) strived to implement the diversified activities to address the various quality related issues during the post Accreditation years. We have multi-dimensional activities to enhance and enrich our academic practices in order to fulfill the recommendations made by NAAC Peer Team. The college smoothly fulfilled the above 10 recommendations made by the NAAC Peer Team. We are trying sincerely to reach the excellence by improvising our innate qualities, adopting innovative ideas, acquiring new skills, implementing new techniques and better understanding of our strength and weaknesses. Integrated efforts and positive approach will lead us towards the 'Total Quality; our ultimate destination. Keeping in mind the post accreditation recommendations and the local problems and issues—

1. The college introduces MA in Arabic in 2016, Science Stream in 2017, Commerce Stream in 2018, Department of Sanskrit in 2018, Major Course in Home Science in 2016, Major Course in Philosophy in 2017, Major Course in History in 2017 and Major Course in Hindi in 2017. To mitigate the demand of Alumnus and dropout students especially marginal women who discontinued their education due to early marriage and Socio-economic conditions, we have opened study Centre of Distance Education of IDOL and

KK Handique State Open University to provide easy access to higher education to the deprived and drop out students.

2. Central Library of Rupahi College is fully automated with Soul 2.0 and Digitalized with software “D Space”
3. Wi-Fi Facility and BSNL high speed broadband connection with 200 MBPS are well equipped. ITC enable three numbers of digital classrooms has been installed and online class portal has been designed and developed under the URL rupahicollege.co.in
4. To improve the communication skill of the student, certificate course in spoken English and spoken Arabic has been introduced.
5. Regarding functionalization of Women Hostel in the campus, UGC yet to release the arrear amount of Rs 25,00000/ for creation of internal infrastructure and facilities. we shall functionalize it immediately after receiving the arrear amount.
6. Probable Facilities have been provided to physically challenged students.
7. Canteen, mess, parking and sports facilities have been upgraded as per modern standards.
8. Medical facilities have been provided to students, teaching and non-teaching staff through the Rupahi Model Hospital
9. Better Communication Facility is provided through well-furnished newly constructed state high from District headquarter to Rupahi is connected to others internal roads of the villages of the catchment areas. It is independent facility which is quite better than Collective Bus facility.
10. Apart from Skill Development Centre, the College introduces 3 years degree course in B.Voc in 20-2021 with 2 Departments viz. Medical Laboratory Technician and Food Processing and Quality Management, Diploma in Fish & Fishery in 2016, Diploma in Fruits and Vegetable Technology in 2018, Diploma in Beauty and Wellness 2018 and Certificate course in Computer Application in 2016

Moreover, the College trying to open three years degree course in B.Voc in Physiotherapy and Nursing Education.
