



Rupahi College, Rupahi, Nagaon, Assam Structured Feedback of various stakeholders

Eight points structured feedback is received online mode from students, teacher and parents and six point structured feedback is received from alumni on the basic points of curriculum and syllabi approved by the affiliating university categorizing the rating figure into high, moderate and poor pointing to the relevant, benefit, standard, future competency and suggestion for modification and addition of the present curriculum to make it more relevant and student centric and quality infusing genre for institutionalization and internationalization of quality assurance. Feedback is received from 403 students of all departments of end semester in the month of Feb/2021. Regarding the feedback of students, the basic points are- sequence of course, volume of syllabus, objectivity of the course, content of advance learning, practical elements, relevance of the course in the present context etc. As regards to the feedback received from 26 teachers on the content of clarity of objectives, arrangement of syllabus, suitable reference materials to the textbook, balance of curriculum, social relevance etc. Feedback received from 87 Alumni on the points of basic knowledge for career, reflection of learning experience on practical life, elective subject; add on course, self-motivation elements etc. Feedback received from the targeted 916 parents who have the capacity to comprehend the content and its significance. The points contain the measurement of knowledge of their wards, effectiveness of curriculum, relevance to changing scenario and scope of employment. Their feedbacks are analyzed with utmost care in all aspects by IQAC and noted viewpoints and communicated to the Governing Body suggesting measures for improvement.
